



A Place for ALL Athletes

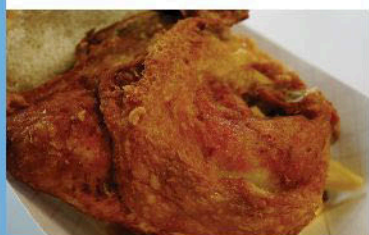
